TUITION FEE

By decision of the University Senate, the tuition fee for the academic year 2022/2023 is established as follows:

Bachelor's studies • 300 Euros/month (2700 Euros/year)

Master's studies • 400 Euros/month (3600 Euros/year)

In order to receive the Romanian visa, you will be required to pay the fee indicated in the acceptance letter issued by the Ministry of Education.

In order to confirm your place, please send us proof of payment of the tuition fee within three weeks from the receipt of the acceptance letter (oana.carnicianu@ase.ro).

REGISTER TO OUR UNIVERSITY

UPON ARRIVAL IN ROMANIA

We kindly ask you to register with our university. The period of registration is **12 September 2022 – 30 September 2022** (registration will be complete after the receipt of the original documents and the completion of a language test, when applicable, according to the law and regulations in force), from Monday to Friday, between 09:30 and 13:30.

The registration office is situated in the main building of the university, 6 Piata Romana, room 0024.

The academic year starts on October 1st. Foreign students have to complete their registration by **October 01 at the latest**. After this date, registration is no longer possible.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR REGISTRATION

- **The diploma allowing access to the level of studies** you apply for:
 - in case of the Bachelor's students – Baccalaureate diploma or its equivalent,
 - in case of the Master's students – Baccalaureate diploma and Bachelor's diploma or their equivalents (the original document and a legal translations in Romanian);

- **The transcript of records corresponding to the previous studies** (High school / Bachelor's), the original document and a legal translations in Romanian;

- **The birth certificate** – copy of the original document and a legal translation in Romanian;

- **A copy of your passport** (ID page & entrance visa);

- **A medical certificate** stating that you don't suffer from contagious diseases or illness incompatible with your future profession – established in an international language or a legal translation in Romanian;

- **The registration fee receipt** (300 Euros for the Bachelor's students, 400 Euros for the Master's students).

The registration is provisional, until the end of the admission process involving: study documents check, presentation of a language certificate and confirmation of payment of the tuition fee for the entire academic year and the completion of a language test.

For the students who satisfy all the admission criteria, the final registration will be complete and they will integrate in the regular cohort of students of the faculty.

CHAPTER 2



ACADEMIC LIFE

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ACADEMIC GENERALITIES

Our university has fully implemented the Bologna system based on three main programmes: Bachelor, Masters, PhD

BACHELOR'S PROGRAMMES

These study programmes are 3 years long (6 semesters) and are assigned 180 ECTS. For admission, applicants must hold a Baccalaureate Diploma or an equivalent, such as a high school degree that allows for the continuation of studies within a higher education institution.

MASTERS' PROGRAMMES

Master's programmes are 2 years long (4 semesters) and are assigned 120 ECTS. For admission, applicants must hold a Bachelor's Diploma or an equivalent. The programmes can be focused on research or on developing specialised professional competences. The academic offer includes 3 international MBA programs, organised in cooperation with foreign partners.

DOCTORAL SCHOOL

The university supports PhD. research corresponding to key areas covered by research centres within each faculty. Generally, PhD studies are 3 years long and are open to Masters' degree holders.

The Academic Structure

The academic year has two semesters. The first semester starts at the beginning of October and is completed by mid-February. The second semester runs from late February to late June. The exact duration of each specific programme can be checked with the individual programme outline. The two regular examination periods are at end of January – beginning of February and end of May – mid-June. The re-examination session takes place in the second half of June – beginning of July.

READING THE TIMETABLE



SINCE EACH ACADEMIC YEAR

is divided into 2 semesters and each semester has a different set of courses and associated seminars, it only makes sense that each semester has a different timetable. The corresponding one for the first semester is published a few days prior to the beginning of the academic year, either or both on the news faculty board or on the faculty's website.

YOU SHOULD KEEP IN MIND THAT

during the first week of the semester some changes may be made in your timetable, so check the board of your faculty. All the students from the same year of study are divided into series and each series is divided into up to 8 groups.

THE COURSES ARE WEEKLY ACTIVITIES

The courses are weekly activities and they are a whole series activity. Some have mandatory attendance and some don't, depending on the professor's preference. It is, of course, advisable to attend all courses.

SEMINARS ON THE OTHER HAND

place either every week or once in every weeks. They are a group activity and have a practical allure. The attendance is mandatory and usually essential in order to pass the course.

The activity which will take place once every two weeks will be marked by a diagonal line in the box corresponding to that seminar. The subjects that are written above that line will take place in the odd weeks (the 1st week, the 3rd week, the 5th week etc.), while the ones that are written under that line will take place in the even weeks (the 2nd week, the 4th week, the 6th week etc.).

COURSE VS SEMINAR

One discipline will be divided into courses and seminars. The mark that you get in seminars represents 30%-40% out of the final mark, while the mark from courses represents 60%-70% of the final mark. The split may differ among courses and will be presented by each course's professor at the beginning of the semester.

ECTS

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies works based on the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System, as part of the Bologna Educational System. Each semester's courses comprise a maximum of 30 ECTS. In order to pass from the first to the second year of Bachelor studies you need a minimum of 30 ECTS at the end of the first academic year (our of the total of 60 ECTS you can get throughout the year). In order to pass from the 2nd to the 3rd year, you need 75 ECTS (our of the total 120 ECTS corresponding to the first 2 years) and in order to enroll for the Bachelor thesis you need all the 180 ECTS.

HOW WILL YOU BE ASSESSED?

The academic year is divided into 2 semesters, each one of them consisting in 14 teaching weeks. At the end of each semester, 3 weeks are assigned students examination, consisting usually in written papers. At the end of the academic year there will be another 2 weeks period of re-evaluation, intended for the ones who want to improve their marks or for the ones who didn't pass an exam and need to re-sit exams. In order to pass in a course and get the corresponding number of ECTS, you need to get at least 50% (translated into mark 5).

The final mark is calculated taking into consideration the seminar points and the final exam mark.

HOW DOES THE PERSONAL PAGE HELP ME?

The facilities of your personal page include your timetable, the planning of your exams and your grades. Moreover, on your personal page you will find information about the fees with which you are due (tuition fees or dormitories fees, in case you obtain a place in the university's dormitories). In addition to that, on the personal page you can find several announcements that may be of interest.

WHICH ARE THE SITUATIONS WHEN THE PERSONAL PAGE CANNOT BE USED?

In case you are living in one of the university dormitories and you are not paying the monthly rent, the access to your personal page will be blocked. In case this thing happens, for unlocking your personal page, you will have to go with the receipt or document which certified that you have paid your debts to the Social Direction from the Cihoschi Building, room 5104 at the 1st floor. In case you cannot access it from different reasons, ask for help from your faculty's secretary's office or contact the Networks Service within ASE (room 2000A).

LIBRARIES IN ASE

The university libraries focus on developing student's global knowledge of the socio-economic field by continually and extensively enriching their collections. The virtual library was established in 2002 and since then it has been one of the focus points of the development process.

ASE libraries are located in Piata Romana and in the Moxa Campus. The library is open from Monday to Friday, between 8:00 and 15:30, offering access to paper and digital resources.

The virtual library allows access to more than 155.000 books, 263 ancient books, more than 1000 full-text articles issued in ASE publications, more than 7000 PhD theses, as well as national and international data bases and publications. The most requested publications are on free access in the library rooms (they are classified according to the Dewey system). Due to the large number of publications, for some of them the access is indirect, through the librarian.

SPORT FACILITIES

MEDICAL SERVICES



All international students are required to have a medical insurance valid for the entire period of studies with ASE – either the European health card or a private insurance.

Medical examinations are free at ASE students' cabinets and they are carried out at the doctor's studio (Moxa campus) – general physician (3 doctors and 5 nurses) and dentist (4 doctors and 3 nurses) offices. Specialist examinations must be requested by your general physician and will be carried out in a specialised unit.

The doctors are available from Monday to Friday, between 08:00 and 19:00.
The medical office can be contacted at **021.319.19.00**, interior **541**.

EU students with EU health card or Health Certificate can go directly to the general doctors they have chosen. Some consultation or investigations might be subject to special fees (partial or no payment from your insurance). In case of emergency situations, the number 112 is available nationwide, free of charge in any telecom network. All hospitals have an emergency room, available 24 hours a day. The service is generally free and open to everybody.





CULTURE AND LEISURE

The Peasant and Village Museums should probably take priority, as well as the Grigore Antipa National History Museum.

While still the most famous building in the city and usually top of the agenda for most visitors, Casa Poporului/Palatul Parlamentului tends to be a bit of a let down for most, mainly due to the stilted nature of the compulsory guided tour. Art lovers - especially fans of religious art - should pencil in at least an afternoon at the National Art Museum.



VILLAGE MUSEUM

Founded by Royal Decree in 1936, and covering some 15 hectares on the shores of Lake Herăstrău, Muzeul Satului is one of the greatest outdoor museums in the Balkans.
